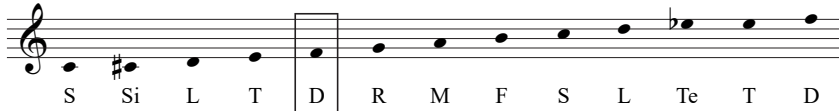

*With the Holy Spirit in the glory of God the Father.*

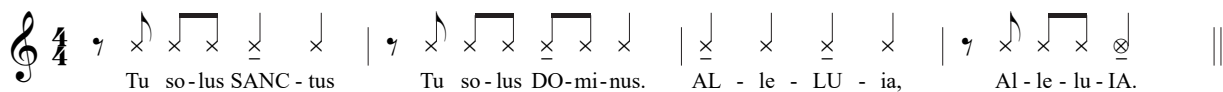
**Tu solus sanctus Tu solus Dominus Alleluia**
